

A Stroll with the Mayor

Pedestrian Roads as Gathering Places

The hot days continue. Please be careful to avoid heatstroke.

Urayasu is the only city in Chiba Prefecture without agriculture. Although Urayasu once thrived as a fishing town, rice farming and other agricultural activities were also carried out. However, due to land subsidence from around 1960, natural drainage of paddy fields became impossible, making rice cultivation difficult.

As a result, a "land improvement project" was carried out to consolidate and re-plot the farmland. Subsequently, with the opening of the Tozai Subway Line, urbanization rapidly progressed, and agricultural land was converted into residential

In the Kitazakae, Nekozane, and Tōdaijima areas, there are pedestrian roads that are 5.5-meter wide.

These roads were originally agricultural waterways developed under the land improvement project, but were opened for public use as roads with the progress of residential development. However, due to their structure where the waterways were covered and paved, vehicle traffic was restricted. Currently, though they are still used as rainwater drainage facilities, they are not structurally designed to allow regular vehicle traffic. Vehicle traffic is restricted with some exceptions.

Therefore, considering the current situation where there are many tall buildings such as apartments around these roads, the city plans to redevelop them into a road structure that allows large vehicles such as fire trucks to pass through in case of emergencies, while maintaining their primary designation as pedestrian-only roads. In addition,

taking advantage of the pedestrian-friendly nature of these roads, we are also considering utilizing the 5.5-meter wide space as a place where citizens can gather and feel comfortable. We will also promote experimental initiatives through the art project "Urayasu Geidai," a collaborative project with Tokyo University of the Arts.

We will develop initiatives that organically link the safety of the city, gathering places for citizens, and the functions of roads.
