Application for Disability Deduction

Even if you do not possess a Physical Disability Certificate, Mental Disability Certificate, or Rehabilitation Certificate, individuals aged 65 or older as of the reference date who are categorized as Care Need Level 1 to 5 (or who possess a Long-Term Care Insurance Card) may be eligible for a Disability Deduction. Individuals who have been certified as eligible for the Disability Deduction, or those who

support such a person, can receive the deduction by presenting the Certificate of Eligibility for Disability Deduction when filing their final income tax return (Kakutei Shinkoku) or their Municipal/Prefectural Resident Tax Declaration.

A New Form of School Clubs

As the number of children and students decreases, school club activities (Bukatsudō) are undergoing significant changes.

Clubs that were once found in every school are shrinking due to the decline in student numbers, making team sports difficult, or lacking teaching staff to serve as advisors.

In particular, some children who wish to specialize in sports are now active not in school clubs, but in community-based club teams that have highly specialized coaches. Furthermore, challenges related to the work style reform for teachers are becoming apparent.

In this context, new initiatives are beginning that are not limited to individual schools.

Called the "URAYASU Culture Club," this initiative focuses on cultural activities that have not

traditionally been part of school club programs.

It matches the teachers' areas of expertise with the interests of children and students, recruiting participants from all schools to conduct activities.

Currently, the initiative covers four areas: "Entomology," "Photography," "Othello," and "Cooking." Although activities are held roughly every two or three months, all clubs are generating excitement, largely because they align with the teachers' areas of expertise.

Although this initiative began as a trial, its scope is expected to expand in the future, possibly involving community center activities and collaboration with local residents.

Moreover, the idea is not limited to expanding cultural fields; it could also be implemented in sports

clubs that have few coaches or participants.

As the Community School initiative begins and schools explore collaboration with the local community, this new form of school club activity has the potential for significant expansion and is believed to broaden the future possibilities for children and students.
