Review Basic Garbage Disposal Rules



Please follow the rules set forth to properly dispose bulky items and household appliances. There have been reports that due to garbage not being sorted correctly, there was a delay in the garbage collection schedule, and that this also resulted in garbage truck fires. We kindly ask for your cooperation in sorting out your garbage properly, for safer and smoother garbage collection purposes.

Basic garbage disposal rules

- Garbage and recyclable resources should be placed outside between $7 \sim 8$ a.m. on the collection day
- Up to five bags can be disposed of per collection
- Non-combustible and hazardous waste should be disposed in the same location as combustible waste
 Note: Not in the same location as recyclable resources
- Drain water from food scraps before disposing
- Do not use garbage bins with lids (such as plastic buckets with lids), because they cause delays in the garbage collection schedule. If you wish to use a box-shaped bin, choose a low and transparent one so the contents inside are visible, and make sure to keep the lid off.

Garbage with risks of igniting trash fires

Improperly discarding spray cans and lighters with flammable liquid still left inside can cause garbage truck fires or trash fires and explosions at garbage collection sites, which may result in life-threatening risks. It also delays the garbage collection schedule and requires a great amount of cost and time for cleanup. Please make sure to empty out the containers before disposing them as non-combustible waste. If you wish to dis-

card spray cans and lighters with liquid remaining, please directly bring them to the Garbage-Free Section (Urayasu City Hall, 6F).

Tips on how to dispose garbage

Bulky items cannot be disposed using the designated garbage bags, even if the item seems to fit inside. Garbage that falls under the following criteria are considered as bulky items:

- ► Items with any single dimension exceeding 50cm but is no more than 200cm
- ▶ Items of which the total of width × height × depth exceed 20,000cm³


Plan your garbage disposal

You can apply to discard up to 5 items at a time at the Bulky Items Reception Center. The next earliest application can only be made 7 days after your first application date (or after the collection date for digital applications), so disposal should be planned in advance. If you wish to dispose all your items together at once, please directly bring them in to the Clean Center, or request a visit from a garbage collection company approved by Urayasu City.

How to dispose bulky items

Request the Bulky Items Reception Center to collect your items, bring them in directly, or make a request to a collection company approved by Urayasu City.

Novel Coronavirus Vaccination Availability

Vaccinations for novel coronavirus will be available for elderly citizens (65 years and older), starting from the week of April 19. However, since the vaccine supply is limited, Urayasu City will proceed with vaccinations in accordance with the following policy for the foreseeable future.



Vaccination Schedule for the Elderly

To minimize the number of severe cases and to prevent the occurrence of coronavirus infection clusters, vaccinations are scheduled to begin at facilities for the elderly starting late-**April**.

Group vaccinations at public facilities are scheduled to begin from early-**May**.

Individual vaccinations at medical institutions are scheduled to begin from early-**lune**.

Vaccination tickets will be sent at different times based on vaccine availability.

- Citizens 75 years and older (born before April 1, 1947) Sent sequentially starting April 12.
- Citizens between 65 years to 74 years April 19

Two vaccination shots are required, with a three-week interval in between (19 to 21 days). Please schedule two appointments together when making your reservation. The vaccination is free of charge. Please be careful of scams.

Enhanced subsidies starting April 1, 2021

Support System for Elderly Drivers Voluntarily Returning Driver's Licenses

In recent years, tragic accidents due to driver errors unique to elderly drivers are frequently reported nationwide, and this is now recognized as a social problem. In order to support elderly residents who have voluntarily returned their driver's licenses, Urayasu City will begin a system that offers certain benefits and services to those who present a driving record history certificate. Benefits and services will vary depending on the store.

Start Date: April 1 (Thu.)

Eligibility: Urayasu City residents over the age of 65 who have voluntarily returned their driver's license and now possess a driving record history certificate or a My Number Card with a sticker indicating the issuance of a driving record history certificate.

Participating Stores: This sticker is the indicator. You can also check for participating stores from the homepage.

Cancellation of Group Vaccination for Rabies

Group vaccination for rabies will be cancelled in order to prevent the spread of novel coronavirus infection. Please apply for a vaccination at your primary veterinary hospital. Vaccination fees vary depending on the veterinary hospital. Please contact the hospital for more information.

Regarding veterinary hospital vaccinations

• When receiving a vaccine at a commissioned

veterinary hospital in Urayasu City

Applications for a rabies vaccination shot and for a rabies vaccination certificate can be processed at the same time. Please bring an item that indicates the registration number for your dog.

When receiving a vaccine at a veterinary hospital outside of Urayasu City

If you have not received a rabies vaccination certificate from a veterinary hospital in Urayasu City, a "rabies vaccination certificate" can be issued by a different veterinary hospital. Please complete the procedure at Environmental Health Section (Urayasu City Hall 6F) (fee ¥550).

Collecting Used Cooking Oil, Used Clothes and Fabrics

Date and time: April 11 (Sun.), 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. **Location:** Urayasu City Hall 1F Citizen's Hall, local public halls

Eligibility: Used cooking oil from households, suits, shirts, sweaters, pants, towels, handkerchiefs, towel blankets, blankets, gloves, kimonos, sheets, curtains, neckties, and undergarments/socks/stockings (new or unused only)

Scholarship Support Fund

Urayasu City provides a scholarship support fund that does not need to be returned, to students who meet the following criteria:

Eligibility: Those with a guardian residing in Urayasu City, registered in the basic resident registration system for one year or longer, enrolled in high school or university, and who meet the following requirements

Grade Requirement:

High School = grade average for previous year was 3.0 or higher on a five point GPA scale. University = grade average for the 3rd

year of high school was 3.0 or higher on a five point GPA scale.

Income Requirement:

Income for previous year before application was 1.3 times lower than the welfare base amount.

Scholarship Amount:

High school = ¥5,000 per month. University = ¥15,000 per month (¥30,000 per month for those who had a grade average of 3.8 or higher on a five point GPA scale, for their 3rd year of high school)

Submit the application form [available at the Education Administration Section (Urayasu City Hall 7F) or download from Urayasu City website] directly to the Education Administration Section between April 15 (Thu.) and May 31 (Mon.)
