National Pension Insurance Fee

As a temporary special measure, if your income declined considerably due to the impact of novel coronavirus infection, the National Pension Insurance fee may be exempt by reporting the estimated income amount in a simple application procedure. The National Pension Insurance Fee after February 2020 will be subject to this procedure. Welfare Service for Single-parent Households

Child Support Allowance

This will be provided to the father or mother of a single-parent household, or to the person who is raising the child in place of the child's father or mother. The child must meet the eligibility requirements by the first March 31 after the child's 18th birthday (until the age of 20 if the child has a disability specified by a Cabinet Order) (income caps are applied).



Note: Submittance of status report is necessary (the document will be sent to the subject at the end of July). Please submit the notice by August 31 (Tue.)

Special Child-Rearing Allowance (for single-parent households)

If you are not receiving Child Support Allowance due to income caps, but if your income has declined due to the impact of novel coronavirus infections, you may still be eligible to receive special benefits. Please consult us.

Single-Parent Housing Allowance

This will be provided to the householder of a single-parent household who is raising a child under the age of 20, if they are paying a monthly rent of over ¥10,000 (income caps are applied).

Note: Submittance of status report is necessary (the document will be sent to the subject at the end of July). Please submit the notice by August 31 (Tue.)

Medical Expenses Subsidy for Single-Parent Household

Copayment subsidy of medical expense is available to a single-parent household, covering health insurance treatments for the father/mother, caregiver of a child, or the child. Applications must be filed by the first March 31 after the child's 18th birthday (until the age of 20 if the child has a disability specified by a Cabinet Order) (income caps are applied).

From November 1 (Mon.), the system will require the Subsidy Card to be shown, and the copayment amount will change.

Previously, it was necessary to submit receipts to the Child Services Section in order to receive medical expenses subsidy. However, as with the Child Medical Expenses Subsidy, from November, if you receive medical treatment within institutions in Chiba Prefecture, present your Child Medical Subsidy Card and pay your self-payment amount listed below at the counter (free for tax-exempt households.)

Hospitalization: ¥300 per day; Outpatient: ¥300 per medical examination; Prescription: free

Shelters and Sheltering at Home earthquake. Therefore, the name for temporary evac-

Thank you for your cooperation in preventing the spread of novel coronavirus infection.

Regarding vaccination, we will continue to strengthen our vaccination system, so those who wish to be inoculated can receive their vaccination as soon as possible.

Now, the typhoon season is approaching.

Flood disaster prevention is a major, inevitable challenge for our city, since we are surrounded by water on three sides. We would also need to keep the pandemic in mind when considering preventive measures.

At the time of Typhoon No. 19 (Hagibis) two years ago, Urayasu City set up a Temporary Evacuation Shelter (*ichiji hinanjyo*) where citizens can evacuate voluntarily, giving priority to the safety of our citizens. However, we were advised that the name may cause confusion with the shelters set up during the coronav of control of

earthquake. Therefore, the name for temporary evacuation locations has been modified to Temporary Retreat Center (*taihijo*) for all future uses.

Temporary Retreat Center (taihijo) is somewhere you temporarily evacuate to in order to protect yourself from harm, and an Evacuation Site (hinanjo) is set up for daily living purposes over a certain period of time, for example, in the event of an earthquake.

You may bring your pets to all Evacuation Sites, however, for Temporary Retreat Centers, pets are only allowed in designated sites (Traffic Park and Todaijima Public Hall parking.)

People tend to become anxious when a typhoon is approaching, but evacuating to shelters in this novel coronavirus situation can also present a greater risk of contracting the infection. If your house is in a safe location, please consider the option of "sheltering at home" rather than going to a shelter. Also, perform "vertical evacuation," by evacuating to higher ground.

Additionally, it's important to always prepare items you would need when disaster strikes, such as water, food, a flash light, and medications.

Urayasu City will provide timely information to assist our residents in making decisions regarding their evacuation. Information will be communicated through various means such as early warning messages sent via mobile carriers, our website, Twitter, and through disaster management radio communication system. Also, we will install materials and equipment necessary to prevent infections and for evacuation purposes.
