You Can File Your Tax **Return Using a Computer** or Smartphone

From the National Tax Agency website, access the "Final Tax Return Preparation Corner" (https://www.keisan.nta.go.jp), and by

simply entering numbers following the instructions that appear on screen, you can either create a tax return for your income tax, submit it using e-Tax

(electronic application), or print it out from the website.



Income Tax Return Consultation Services

After consultation regarding your application, you can submit the form using e-Tax at the venue.

A Stroll with the Mayor

Transferring Jurisdiction of the Metropolitan Expressway Bayshore Route Maihama Entrance

through Urayasu City, playing a key role as the main route that distributes commodities within the metropolitan area. In Urayasu City, there are two entrances to the expressway and one exit.

As for the Maihama Entrance (Maihama connection), it has undergone maintenance to be used as a tempo-



The Metropolitan Expressway Bayshore Route runs rary facility in order to alleviate traffic during the 2001 opening of Tokyo DisneySea®. Urayasu City continues to manage this entrance, and cases like this are quite rare even across the country.

> Although this is not a well-known fact, the Urayasu City section of the Bayshore Route is a prefectural route, not a national route, and it is managed by the Metropolitan Expressway Co., Ltd. authorized by Chiba Prefecture. Therefore, the Maihama Entrance should also be managed this way, in accordance with the proper arrangements.

> Although the distance from the Urayasu City Arterial Road #6 to the merging section is only a short 883 meters, it should still be managed following the same standard as the expressway. From when the road first opened, Urayasu City has expended about 150 million yen for its maintenance and construction. In addition to the maintenance fee, it is estimated that significant ex

penses will further be incurred if the pavement, electrical equipment, and bridge, among other sections, needs to be repaired.

With these factors in mind, Urayasu City has repeatedly requested for relevant entities to recognize the Maihama Entrance as a Chiba prefectural route, just the same as the Urayasu Entrance and Chidoricho Entrance. They are asking to transfer its jurisdiction so that it will be managed by the Metropolitan Expressway Co., Ltd., according to proper arrangements.

As a result, in November 2022, a Maihama regional traffic review meeting was held by relevant entities and the need to make the Maihama Entrance a permanent establishment was recognized. Discussions are now being held to review specific conditions to enable the transfer of its jurisdiction. We will continue to hold further discussions for the jurisdiction transfer to be completed as soon as possible, so that it will be managed in accordance with the proper arrangements.
