Urayasu Disaster Preparedness App

Now Available for Download

The city has released “Urayasu Disaster Preparedness App,” a smartphone app that delivers Urayasu Disaster Preparedness information to users. The Urayasu Disaster Preparedness App has many functions to help you take quick and appropriate evacuation action in an emergency. Download the app to prepare for disasters that can strike at any time.

What can the app do?

Receive the necessary information at any time

You will receive push notifications allowing you to check information from the disaster preparedness public address system in both audio and text formats at any time and from any location.

In the event of a disaster or when there is a risk of a disaster, the screen will switch to emergency mode to alert users.



Obtain disaster preparedness information

The app contains disaster preparedness information such as water hazard maps and manuals on how to respond to disasters.



Check location of evacuation sites

Evacuation sites and locations with AEDs are listed on the in-app map. You can easily check for the availability and crowd level of evacuation sites during a disaster.



Available in multiple languages

In addition to Japanese, English, Chinese (traditional and simplified), Korean, Vietnamese and Portuguese, it is also available in Simple Japanese that is easy to understand even for foreigners.



How to download

① Scan the QR code on the right or search for “Life Vision” in Google Play or the App Store to download the app.

Note: You are responsible for all communication charges related to downloading or using the app. Some or all functions of the app may be unavailable depending on your environment or device.

② Click “Select area and log in”.

③ Enter your postal code and click “Search”.

④ Confirm that “Urayasu City, Chiba Prefecture” is displayed then click “Next”.

⑤ Select the area for which you wish to receive information on.

⑥ Read the terms of use and click “Accept”.

“Paperless Counter” Service Has Started!

The “paperless counter” service has started for some procedures, such as the issuance of certificates and notification of change of residence. You can prepare applications in advance using your smartphone or automatically using your My Number Card, reducing the burden of preparing applications by hand and saving time.

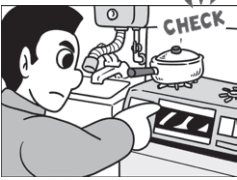

Finding Life’s Passions at the Senior Citizens Human Resources Center

Although spring is approaching according to the calendar, forecasts show that the cold weather will still continue for a while. Please take care of yourself to handle the cold.

Our city was once known as the youngest city in Japan, but with the end of large-scale housing development, the population is aging rapidly. It is predicted that by 2040, the percentage of senior citizens in the city’s population will rise to 27.7 percent.

In light of these facts, I would like to introduce the Senior Citizens Human Resources Center. These are facilities where people aged sixty and over can find their life’s passion through work and contribute to the revitalization of local communities.

Senior Citizens Human Resources Centers are incorporated organizations established in each municipality based on the Act on Employment Security of Elderly Persons. They provide employment opportunities tailored to the lifestyles

of retired people who are still willing to work.

The Urayasu Senior Citizens Human Resources Center was established in 1988, and is operated based on the philosophy of “autonomy, independence, cooperation, and mutual assistance”, with the full agreement and active participation of its members.

The aim of the work at the center is to enable senior citizens to find life’s passion and contribute to the local community by putting their knowledge, experience and skills to use in employment, so the work is often easy to handle. Specific examples include managing sports facilities and bicycle parking lots, and cleaning public facilities.

They also provide work when requested by residents, such as replacing shoji screens, watering gardens, providing housekeeping services, and writing calligraphy.

Currently over 300 residents are registered with the center, but the number of members is on the decline

due to factors such as the raising of the retirement age.

The Senior Citizens Human Resources Center regularly holds information sessions to recruit new members and accepts requests for work.

The city will continue to provide support for social participation for senior citizens so that each and every resident can live as themselves regardless of age.
